1. Nomad LT includes:
 - a. Document camera
 - b. Hard-wired HDMI and USB-C cables
 - c. Blu-ray player
 - d. Built-in computer
 - e. Wireless connection for personal devices
 - f. Touch-screen confidence monitor with annotation capability
 - g. Pre-programmed control system
 - h. Built-in sound system
 - i. Gooseneck microphone

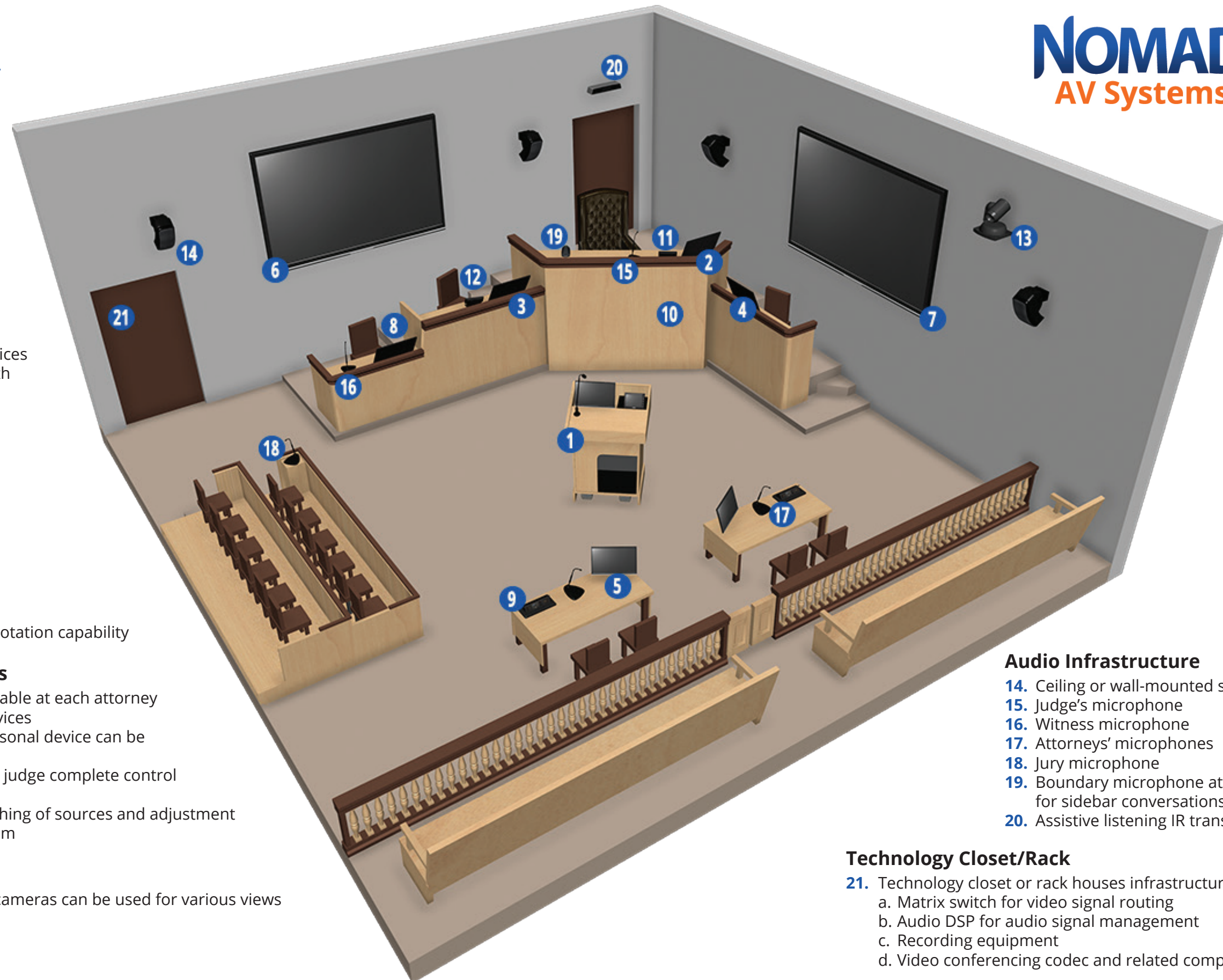
2. Judge's monitor
3. Clerk's monitor
4. Bailiff's monitor
5. Attorney's monitors
6. Gallery viewing monitor
7. Jury viewing monitor
8. Touch-screen witness monitor with annotation capability

External Inputs and Control Panels

9. Attorney table inputs – an HDMI input cable at each attorney table allows wired input of personal devices
10. Judge's input – Judge's private PC or personal device can be displayed on courtroom monitors
11. Judge override control panel – gives the judge complete control over what is presented
12. Clerk's control panel – can control switching of sources and adjustment of audio levels throughout the courtroom

Video Conferencing

13. PTZ (Pan-Tilt-Zoom) camera – multiple cameras can be used for various views

14. Ceiling or wall-mounted speakers
15. Judge's microphone
16. Witness microphone
17. Attorneys' microphones
18. Jury microphone
19. Boundary microphone at judge's bench for sidebar conversations
20. Assistive listening IR transmitter

21. Technology closet or rack houses infrastructure equipment
 - a. Matrix switch for video signal routing
 - b. Audio DSP for audio signal management
 - c. Recording equipment
 - d. Video conferencing codec and related components
